The KPA Board appointed three new Certified Kentucky Paralegals to the KPA Certification Committee (KPACC). If you know a paralegal who is interested in taking the exam, please let them know they do not have to be a member to review the information, or to sit for the exam. One must only be a KPA member once they have attained their CKP status. The fee for testing includes a one-year membership with the KPA.

Continuing Paralegal Education (CPE) information will soon be posted to the Website, also. To date, if you are a CKP and have attended a CPE or CLE, please keep your information and you may submit several confirmations at one time. The deadline for submitting CPE credit is December 31, 2011, for those who tested in November, 2010. More information regarding CPEs will be available in March.
